ANNOUNCEMENT TO SELECT TRAINING APPLICANTS WHO ARE WORKING IN THE CYCLOTRON FACILITY, NATIONAL DIAGNOSTIC AND TREATMENT CENTER, MINISTRY OF HEALTH

Within a grant program of Korea Foundation for International Healthcare (KOFIH), “MON-8” The Government of the Republic of Korea with the operation and management of the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) Loan Project is calling an open announcement to select as below 5 long-term training applicants who will be working in the Cyclotron Facility, Nuclear Medicine Department, National Diagnostic and Treatment Center of Ministry of Health.

Description of responsibilities:

In order to provide a range of isotope producing technical and operational administration duties of the Cyclotron Facility, the selected applicants shall participate in the long-term specialized training at the Korea Institute of Radiological & Medical institute (KIRAMS), and make at least 5 year’s contract with Ministry of Health, Mongolia.

The general requirement:

Applicants should be a qualification in medicine, chemical technology, pharmacology, and radiation safety control as well as familiar with the law, rules, regulation, and standards of nuclear energy, radiation protection in Mongolia.

1. Nuclear Medicine Physician

- Medical doctor with Imaging Diagnostic specialization
- Sub-specialized in Nuclear Medicine (Qualified Nuclear Medicine physician)
- At least 3 years of clinical practice experience as a Nuclear medicine physician
- Proficiency in English
- Required to have Medical code of ethics

2. PET/CT Technician

- Medical technician with at least 2 years of work experience in handling radiology equipment
- Proficiency in English or Korean
- Required to have medical code of ethics

3. Cyclotron operator

- B.A or above in electrical engineering
- 2 or more years of work experience
- Proficiency in English or Korean

4. Radiopharmacist

- Qualified pharmacist with a license
- B.A or above in pharmacy from accredited school of pharmacy
- Proficiency in English
- Required to have medical code of ethics

5. Radiochemist

- B.A or above in chemistry, pharmacy /a pharmaceutical analyst/ , biomedical science, biochemistry
- Proficiency in English
- Required to have Medical code of ethics

Interested and qualified applicants must submit the following documents in Mongolian and English.

- Curriculum vitae or resume
- A copy of diploma and certificates /notarized/
- Grade Point Average record /notarized/
- A copy of ID card and Social insurance books /notarized/
- Reference letter from the previous/current employer or professor with contact

- Essay writing about purpose of the designated occupation and safety operation of radiation (until 250 words)

Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted to take a pre-employment training test presentation and interviewed with representatives of Korea Foundation for International Healthcare /KOFIH/ and Korea Institute of Radiological & Medical institute /KIRAMS/ in English.
